We learned about time and temperature and worked on how to tell the time and read temperature in pairs. We also looked at how to answer multiplication word problems.

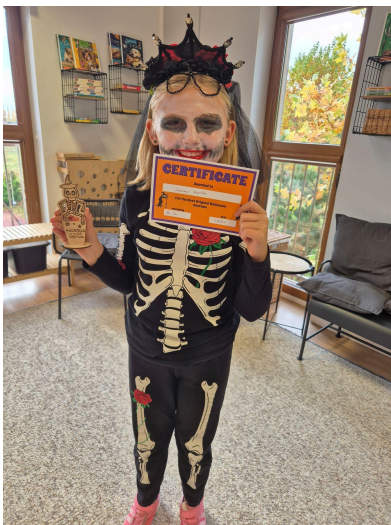
In Social Studies...
