## Language Arts

The students have had a month filled with presentations, group activities, and storytelling. They retold and presented a familiar story, as well as typing up an article about extreme weather conditions, and designing a weather warning poster on extreme weather.



## Math

This month students continued practicing their multiplication facts and learned the step-by-step process to multiply two-digit by two-digit numbers. We played a game and moved up to different levels based on how many multiplication answers we figured out correctly.

## Science

We have been studying ecosystems and the relationships between living things. Students learned about food chains, food webs, and how producers, consumers, and decomposers work together. They also presented what they learned, becoming the teachers for a day. This made the topic easier to understand and fun to share.
