LANGUAGE ARTS

The students have been reviewing and practicing how to report statements and questions in the *past simple*, and conditional. They've also been practicing how to report past simple sentences into past perfect, which they found quite challenging. The students have also been preparing a presentation with their chosen controversial topics, and will present them in class next month.





SCIENCE

Grade 6 continued their study of arthropods by presenting what they learned about subphyla like crustaceans, arachnids, insects, and myriapods. We discussed what all arthropods have in common and what makes each subphylum unique. Everyone did a great job with their group presentations!



HISTORY

Grade 6 students have worked on creating posters about Polish history in the sixteenth century. They worked on researching and presenting about: the Union of Lublin, the First Free Elections, Gdansk and its role in the economy of Poland, the Commonwealth of Many Nations and Religions, and the Golden Age of Polish Culture.

MATHS

Students have been looking at angles, triangles and measurement. They reviewed how to correctly use a protractor and how to calculate missing angles based on information that is given. They created an art project that revolves around creating angles that are complementary.
