Language Arts

Grade 6 students have been preparing for the Spelling Bee competition, by practicing as a class. They have also been preparing a role play called 'TV talk show' which they will be presenting in a couple of weeks.



Math

Students continued to work on making sure that they understand the concept of angles and the different theorems. They were able to draw triangles using rulers and compasses. We also began looking at 2D shapes and their different characteristics.

Science

Before the break, students presented research on the different subphyla of arthropods. They explored what makes arthropods unique and how scientists classify them into smaller groups. Presentations covered key characteristics such as body segments, exoskeletons, and specialized limbs.



History
