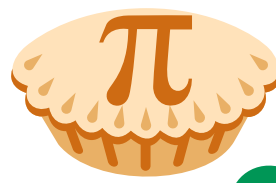


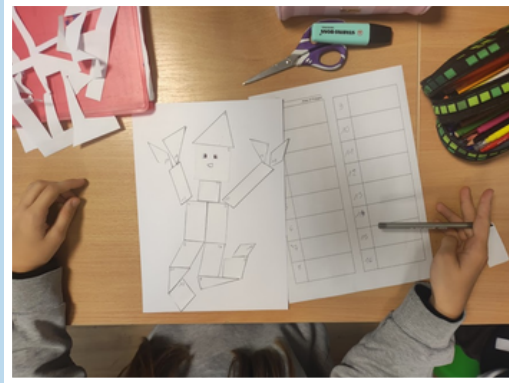
Grade 5

LANGUAGE ARTS

The Grade 5 students have been learning a lot about music this month. The students researched and wrote an article about their favourite musician/artist. They have also been working in groups writing songs and poetry about their country, and the importance of life socially.



MATHEMATICS
