LANGUAGE ARTS

The Grade 7 students have been learning about idioms the last few weeks, and how to use them in different situations. The students have also been doing some informative writing, using adverbs, subordinating conjunctions and common English expressions.



MATHEMATICS

Students created posters explaining how to solve multi-step equations. They worked in small groups to solve several equation types. We were able to celebrate pi day and create a visual representation of pi to 100 digits after the decimal point and learn why the number is important.



HISTORY

Students presented their Google Slide presentations to their peers. They summed up the unit with information about the Paris Peace agreement and the consequences of the war. They were able to clearly reflect on the results and outcomes and how they led to the next conflict.

SCIENCE
